

IDOCOS aims

- To support and facilitate university staff and doctoral students across universities in different countries
 - -in co-creation and sharing of digitalised courses and open learning materials prepared for quality online, flexible and blended teaching and learning
 - -in adopting a scalable and robust methodology for co-creation and sharing of digitalised courses
 - -provide access to shared courses and open learning materials for teaching and learning
 - -in using relevant tools, (open when available) for co-creation and sharing of open courses and learning materials
 - in building competencies for digital transformation

IDOCOS deliverables/outputs (IO):

- IO1 The methodology documented in a handbook.
- IO2 A demonstration course in Digital Transformation.
- An updated open textbook "Digital transformation: Organisations, Processes, Decisions Strategies for a Digitised Century".
- IO3 Delivery of the Doctoral course in Digital Transformation on a shared digital platform supporting doctoral education, supervision and student learning processes.
- IO4 A simple digital supported platform/demonstrator for the methodology, making the related OERs/OAs and course accessible.

The course: Digital Transformation

Two groups

- A group of 50 students from partners UiB and KTH that are supervised through 2 seminars.
 - Students to deliver two reports, peer reviewed by co-students.
 - To be assessed pass or no pass.
 - If correctly registered, will receive a certificate and 3,5 credits for passing.
- An open group, 1.600 registered as interested about 400 into the LMS.
 - Students to study the course on their own, videos from seminars will be made available.
 - Students can interact with each others in a general forum.
 - Can deliver a report. Up two 30 reports to be evaluated, the five best to awarded as best reports, can be published on the IDOCOS web.
 - The student can locally consult his/her university/supervisor to see if credits can be considered.
